Team Name	Min Age	Description
Activities Central	18	Volunteers supervise activities and sell items and activity passes. You may need to direct people, enforce rules, and maintain a fun atmosphere.
Artist Merchandise	16	The number one priority is customer service. Volunteers need to be welcoming, patient, servant-minded and proficient at handling sales. Money exchange, set-up/tear-down and keeping the merchandise presentable are some of the main duties.
Camping Field	14	Volunteers are needed Sunday before Lifest to mark campsites and during the festival to direct campers to their designated sites. You will be outside during your whole shift and should come prepared with sunscreen / bugspray. A welcoming smile and great attitude is a must!
CD Store	16	To work this area you need a desire to serve others, and have knowledge of Christian music, artists and CD's. The CD Store is in the Expo Center. You will be working with customers, answering questions and keeping the merchandise presentable. We need volunteers to handle sales and to be reliable and willing to serve where needed.
Cyber Life Café	16	This is quite possibly the best volunteer gig at Lifest (...says the technology team)! Primary functions will be money exchange, selling tickets which allow users access to the internet, assisting customers with logging in and contacting on-site technical support if issues arise. You will have your own PC to surf the web for free during your shift. This area is located in the Expo Center which is an air-conditioned building! We are looking for people who are friendly and outgoing. Computer skills are helpful but not necessary.
Daily Grounds Clean-Up	12	As part of a team, you will be required to walk the fairgrounds to pick up garbage in order to keep the festival clean. Since you will be outdoors for this job, please dress appropriately.
Dodgeball	18	Volunteers supervise Dodgeball games and should be comfortable directing people and enforcing rules to maintain a fun atmosphere.
Festival Clean-Up	12	<p>You must be a 4-Shift Volunteer to work Festival Clean-Up. You will need to pick each shift listed on the scheduling page to complete the application. You are required to work Sunday, July 12th from 1:30 pm to 8:00 pm and Monday, July 13th from 8:00 am to 9:00 pm. There will be 30 minute breaks for lunch and supper. You can bring your own meals or purchase meals at Volunteer Food for \$3 each. You must supply your own work gloves and be prepared to work outside.</p> <p>To work Festival Clean-Up, you must have adult supervision if you are 12-15 years old (maximum of 6 youth per adult). You are also required to leave a \$50 deposit at Volunteer Registration before you receive your wristband (cash, check or credit card). Deposits will be refunded at the end of the day Monday.</p>
Festival Set-Up	14	<p>Set-Up team has been expanded to include shifts on the weekend before Lifest. Sunday shifts will include Campground Marking Team, Moving Crew and Sign Set-Up. Most jobs require you to lift heavy objects. You will be on foot and outdoors so be prepared for the weather and bring work gloves.</p> <p>You are responsible for your own meals. However, on Tuesday and Wednesday you do have the option to buy lunch at Volunteer Food for \$3 per meal. Meal breaks are only 30 minutes, if you are not eating at Volunteer Food, please bring your own food because there is not enough time to leave the grounds.</p>

Team Name	Min Age	Description
First Aid	18	We are looking for physicians, nurses, CNAs, MAs, Paramedics, EMTs and First Responders. Proof of medical certification is required before you can volunteer. You can fax a copy to 920-738-5587. Please submit your availability and the director of this area will schedule you.
Garbage	12	This job entails picking up garbage outdoors around the fairgrounds, as well as changing garbage bags in designated areas. All supplies and transportation are provided.
Gatekeepers	18	Looking for mature, customer service oriented volunteers to help welcome and direct festival goers at the entry gates at Lifest. You must be assertive and friendly with a positive attitude. The ability to troubleshoot is necessary. You will be outside during the entire shift, a shady area and chair is provided.
HFT Café Stage Crew	18	You will be lifting and moving heavy band and stage equipment. You must be able to lift over 75 lbs. No skirts, dresses, or sandals allowed while working Stage Crew. You must bring your own work gloves.
Junior Security	16	You are required to volunteer with an adult volunteer willing to work with you for all your scheduled shifts. Security is for mature individuals with a Christ-like attitude who will treat all situations and all people with respect and proper protocol.
KidZone Inflatables	14	This volunteer position requires some set-up in the KidZone tent and supervising the inflatable games.
KidZone Team	14	You will be supervising crafts, set-up, clean-up and having fun with the kids!
Lifest Store	16	Volunteers need to be welcoming, patient, and servant-minded. We need volunteers who can handle sales and will keep merchandise presentable. The Lifest Store is located in the Expo Center.
Money Management	18	This area requires attention to detail, excellent with cash and flexibility. Confidentiality is a necessity. You will be serving inside for your whole shift.
Overnight Security	18	Overnight security is scheduled from Midnight to 8:30 am (2 shifts back-to-back). Please indicate your availability for these shifts times. You must be a Half Price of Full Event volunteer to choose this team.
Parking	16	Volunteers are needed to direct incoming festival attendees through the parking area. This area is often the first contact that the general public has with the festival, therefore a smile and enthusiasm is a must. This job will be outdoors and on foot, so come prepared for the weather!
Pit Stage Crew	18	You will be lifting and moving heavy band and stage equipment. You must be able to lift over 75 lbs. No skirts, dresses, or sandals allowed while working Stage Crew. You must bring your own work gloves.
Security	18	This area is for watchful, assertive volunteers who are willing to keep order. Security is for mature individuals with a Christ-like attitude who will treat all situations and all people with respect and proper protocol. You will secure all areas of the festival. If you are willing to work Overnight Security, please choose that team from the previous page.
Ticket Tent	14	All festival attendees enter this tent to purchase tickets, pick-up orders and receive their wristbands. The number one priority is customer service; therefore volunteers need to be welcoming, patient, and servant-minded. Depending on the job assignment, these positions could be under a tent, on foot, or outdoors. Bring rain gear and sun block. Ability to handle money and work on a computer/cash register may be required aspects of this job.
